Brown Act Regulation Changes

Attention Student Body Associations!! Your meeting teleconference guidelines are changing. When the agenda goes out 72 hours in advance, Brown Act requires that all locations of members be disclosed. During the COVID state of emergency the past two years, the law was amended to allow members to teleconference and not disclose their location. Starting March 1st, the state of emergency will be rescinded and all member access points will have to be posted on the agenda again. There are very few exceptions to this requirement but you can watch the Brown Act webinar on our YouTube Channel to hear a comprehensive review of upcoming Brown Act changes and their effect on SBAs.
